Tuckahoe School's budget maintains fiscal prudence. We have prepared a very conservative 2017-18 budget. Actual spending analysis was used in preparing the budget-spending plan. The Board of Trustees and Administration maintain level funding for high quality instructional programs while securing the long-term fiscal stability of the district. The good news for Tuckahoe residents is that under this new budget plan the tax rate will be reduced to an estimated \$7.20 per \$1000. This compares to this current school year rate of \$7.24 per \$1000 and \$7.55 per \$100 in school year 2015-16. The proposed 2017-18 budget continues our commitment to providing instructional technology for each of our students, and allows us to properly maintain the community's investment and continue all programs and activities for students in grades PreK-8.
