WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Tuckahoe Common School District has committed to ensuring a responsible budget for the 2018-2019 school year that ensures adequate and proper instruction and payment of all necessary expenses; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Board of Trustees herein set the tax levy for the 2018-2019 school year for \$18,996,772. This levy is \$100,000 less than the \$19,096,772 budgeted for 2018-2019.
